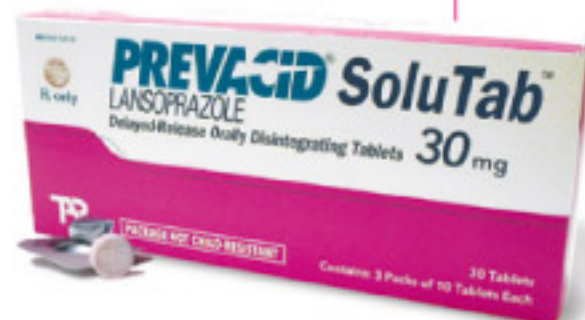

Important Safety and Other Information

- Adverse events reported most frequently for PREVACID were diarrhea (3.8%), abdominal pain (2.1%), and nausea (1.3%).
- Symptomatic response to therapy does not preclude the presence of gastric malignancy.
- PREVACID indications include the short-term treatment of symptomatic GERD and erosive esophagitis.
- PREVACID products should not be crushed or chewed.
- Phenylketonurics: PREVACID SoluTab contains phenylalanine 2.5 mg per 15 mg tablet and 5.1 mg per 30 mg tablet.
